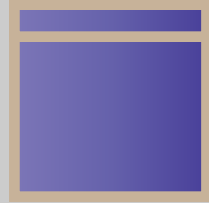
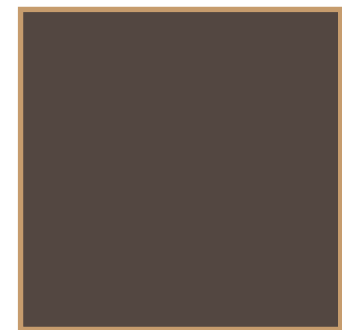
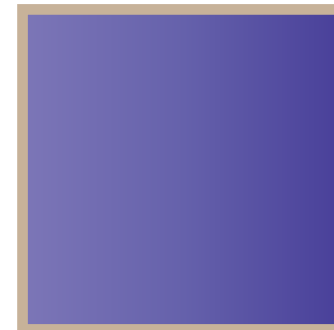


1. Copy square
2. Shorten top square to be pot's brim
3. Select both squares
4. Align Vertical Top
5. Align Horizontal Center



6. Select bottom (larger) square
7. Direct Select tool (white arrow)
8. Click bottom left anchor point
9. Shift + Click bottom right anchor

10. Object menu > Transform > Scale
11. Uniform at 70%
- TIP: Check Preview
12. Click OK
13. Select both objects
14. Group





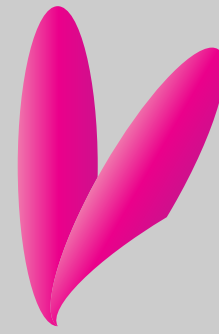
1. Rotate tool
  2. Alt + Click  
bottom anchor point
  3. Angle at  $-30^\circ$
  4. Click Copy
- TIP: Check Preview



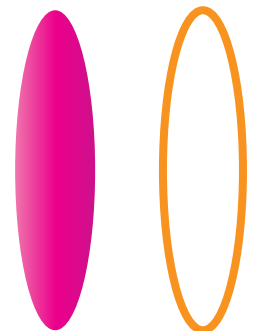
5. Select both petals
  6. Pathfinder Shape Mode  
"Minus Front"
- TIP: Window menu



7. Object menu >  
Transform >  
Transform Again
  8. Repeat 11 times
- TIP: Ctrl + D

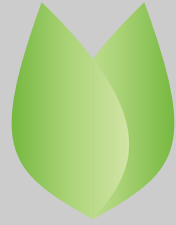


10. Select all petals
11. Group
12. Scale and/or  
Skew





1. Select leaf shape
2. Reflect tool
3. Alt + Click  
bottom anchor point
4. Choose Vertical
5. Click Copy



6. Rotate tool  
and rotate freehand
- TIP: CTRL + Click  
other leaf to select it



Put it all together ...  
Flower, stem, leaves, pot  
TIP: Watch Layers





1. Oval tool
- TIP: Eyedropper tool to copy and apply colors
2. Pen tool >  
Delete Anchor Point tool
  3. Click left side anchor point
  4. Click right side anchor point



5. Direct Selection tool
- TIP: There are two anchor points  
There are four path handles
6. ALT + Click + Drag one of the path handles
- IMPORTANT: Do not click before pressing down ALT
7. Repeat Step 6 for the other three path handles
- TIP: Now, you no longer need ALT  
Continue to drag path handles to shape
